

## ADMISSIONS INFORMATION FOR THOSE APPLYING FOR CHILDREN AGED 3 & 4 YEARS.

To arrange a visit to Hodder House parents will initially need to contact our Admissions Office who will send out a prospectus and arrange an appointment to meet Mr Crouch, the Headmaster and Mrs Lea, the Head of Pre-Prep. When you visit, Mrs Lea will extend a warm welcome and show you our facilities. She will be pleased to answer any of your questions, either about our Foundation Stage or about the rest of the school. After a tour of Hodder House, parents will be invited to meet Mr Crouch and have a tour of St. Mary's Hall.

Children who have turned 3 on or before 31<sup>st</sup> August of the previous academic year can join us either for mornings or afternoons only, for a minimum of 5 sessions (half days) a week, or for the whole day (8.00 am – 3.50 pm) subject to availability. Our morning places are especially popular, and we advise parents to contact the school's Admissions Office as soon as possible to reserve a place.

We take a maximum of 32 full-time children, divided between our FS1 (Nursery) and FS2 (Reception) classes.

We prefer children to be able to dress and undress with minimum help, use the toilet independently and to be able to use a knife and fork before they join us.
