## TUTORIAL SYSTEM

The Tutorial system at the College is in place to improve care and support we provide for our pupils and to enhance the quality of teaching and learning. The Tutor's responsibilities involve many aspects, some of which follow:

- Discussion with tutees and challenging them on their academic progress, subject options, careers etc;
- Taking an interest in and checking their studies;
- Urging their tutees to involve themselves in a range of extra-curricular activities and monitoring the balance between academic and extra curricular commitments;
- Building up a trustful, concerned relationship with their tutees;
- Generally monitoring all aspects of their tutee's development.

## WEEKEND ACTIVITIES

Activities are arranged each weekend for boarding pupils by their Playroom Masters and House Mistresses. These activities are either 'in-house' or extended activities outside college.

The type of activity depends very much on the year group, but we aim to provide a balanced mix of cultural, social and sports' events. We also encourage pupils to put forward their own suggestions for both 'in-house' and extended activities. For instance, Grammar will have several overnight CCF activities as well as more social events such as visiting the Trafford Centre, visiting the coast, go-karting etc.

Weekend activities will be publicised on the College website several days in advance in order to ensure that parents are aware of the extensive opportunities on offer.

Although we encourage pupils to get actively involved, organised activities are not compulsory until a pupil has actually committed himself/herself. This helps to reduce the possibility of last minute withdrawals threatening the feasibility of an event. It is important that a sufficient number of pupils take advantage of what is available.

We will be producing a retrospective photographic record on the College website of what has happened each weekend. Hopefully, this is something that can be built on during the term and will prove both informative and entertaining for pupils, parents and staff.

## INFORMATION FOR PUPILS -PUPIL WELFARE

### Worries, Concerns & Complaints

Things do not always go well at school and pupils should feel confident that there is always someone available who can help them overcome whatever difficulties may arise in all areas of school life.

### Pastoral

The Deputy Head (*Pastoral*) oversees pastoral matters but day-to-day concerns are the responsibility of the Playroom Masters/House Mistresses and designated staff. Tutors play an important role and are allocated at the beginning of each year. The College Chaplains have a significant input as well. Problems can appear to be insurmountable but help is there when required. Any member of staff associated with the pupil's Playroom/House is available to assist and the Health Centre staff are always willing to help.

### Academic

The Deputy Headmaster has overall responsibilities for this area but Heads of Department and Tutors, liaising with all of the pupil's teachers, endeavour to keep a close check on progress. It is important that difficulties should first of all be discussed with subject teachers, but if pupils find this impossible to do, their Tutor will act as an intermediary. The Prefect of Studies has particular responsibility for problems that occur in the classroom and studies, and should be consulted when difficulties arise. The Deputy Headmaster or Deputy Head (*Learning*) will take up persistent difficulties.

### Disciplinary

The Deputy Head (*Pastoral*) promulgates school disciplinary procedures but classroom discipline is largely the responsibility of individual teachers, while the appropriate Playroom Master/House Mistress usually addresses disciplinary matters outside the classroom. Serious disciplinary matters are dealt with immediately by the Deputy Head (*Pastoral*). In disciplinary situations there can be occasions when sanctions are perceived as unfair, and all pupils have a right to express complaints in an appropriate manner. A sensible approach to a person issuing a punishment can usually lead to clarification but, failing this, a pupil's Playroom Master/House Mistress can assist. The Deputy Head (*Pastoral*) is also available at any time.

### School Counsellor

The School Counsellor is Mrs K Aldridge and she is available in the parlour adjacent to Reception between 8:30am and 4:00pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays for anyone who wishes to speak to her on a confidential basis.
